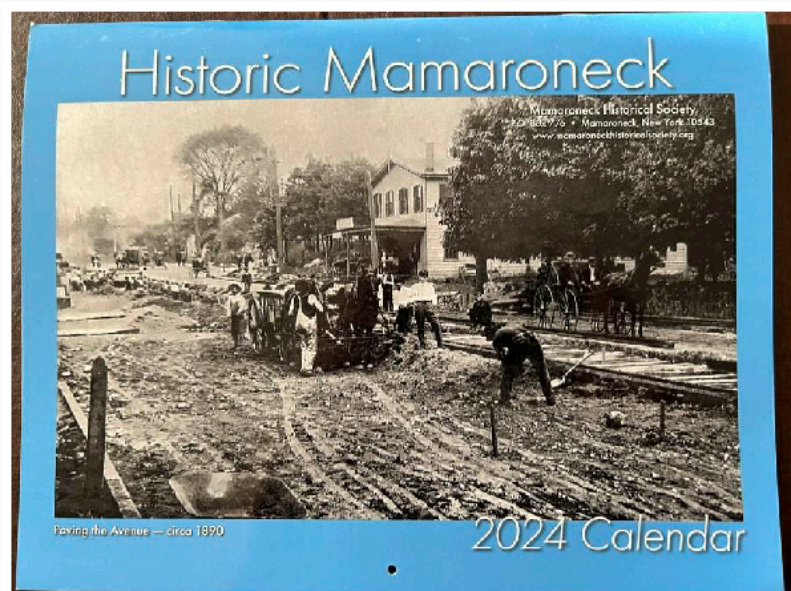

There were five Trustees up for re-election at this meeting:

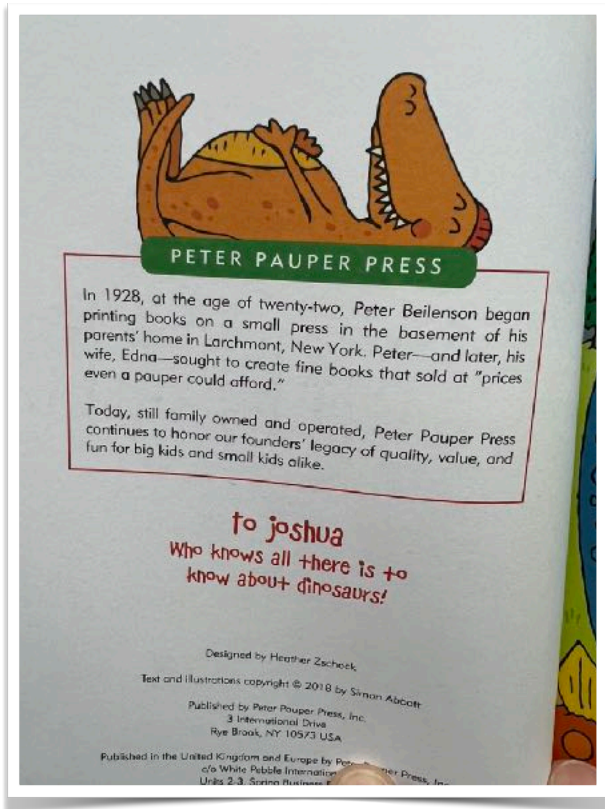
- George Mgrditchian Vice President**
